Selection Criteria:

Athletic Achievement:

- Performance: They demonstrated excellence in sports performance at Central Lake Public Schools.
- Accomplishments: Record of championships, awards, records, or other notable achievements in their sport(s).
- Impact: Significance of their contributions to their team(s) and the school's athletic program.

Leadership and Sportsmanship:

- Character: Exhibited exemplary sportsmanship, leadership, and integrity on and off the field.
- Teamwork: Contributed positively to team dynamics and collaboration.
- Community Impact: Engaged in community service or represented the school positively in the community.

Longevity and Consistency:

- Duration: Played a significant role in school athletics over multiple seasons or years.
- Consistency: Maintained high performance and dedication throughout their athletic career.

Post-Graduation Success:

College and Beyond: Achievements in athletics beyond high school, such as collegiate or professional sports careers.
 Contributions: Continued involvement in athletics, coaching, or mentoring roles that reflect positively on Central Lake
 Public Schools.

Guidelines for Nomination and Selection:

Nomination Process:

- Open Nominations: CLPS solicits community nominations for the Athletic Hall of Fame. Nominations may be made for individuals, teams, or others who have significantly contributed to the CLPS Athletic Community.
- Deadline: August 15th to Dr. Ryan L. Cunningham, Superintendent, 8169 W. State St., PO Box 128, Central Lake, MI 49622, or by email to rcunningham@centrallake.org.

Selection Committee:

- Composition: High School Principal/Athletic Director, Superintendent, Two (2) members of the Board of Education, Two (2) Varsity Coaches (one male and one female), and a member of the Sports Boosters.
- Criteria Review: See above. In addition, the nominee must have retired or graduated from CLPS for at least five (5) years.

Voting and Induction:

- Voting Process: All nominations will be considered and discussed. A tabulation format will be used. A structured ranking or points system helps ensure fairness in evaluating nominees based on established criteria rather than subjective opinions alone.
- Induction Ceremony: An annual induction ceremony to honor selected athletes and celebrate their achievements will be scheduled
- Records and Documentation: The nominee shall provide records of the nominee, their achievements, and the rationale for their selection.

Publicity: The Hall of Fame and its inductees will be promoted through school publications, websites, and community outreach.
